

## Bishops Conference Of England and Wales Catholic Certificate in Religious Studies

The course is a nationally accredited course in Catholic Theology and its application in Religious Education in school and parish. It is valuable for all teachers and an essential requirement for any teacher applying for senior management positions in Catholic education. We also recommend this course for those who may simply wish to expand their knowledge of their faith.

The course consists of six core modules in foundation areas of Theology (Old and New Testament, Sacraments, The Church, Christology / Jesus Christ and Morality) and two professional modules – Faith and Culture, and Catholic Social Teaching.

## General requirements for each module

- 10 hours of teaching.
- A written assignment of 1,500 words or suitable oral presentation.
- Minimum of 80% attendance.
- Modules will be spread over two years.

## Cost

- £50 per module for those completing the certificate.
- £35 per module for attendance only (for those who do not wish to complete essays and obtain the certificates).
- Plus a £20 registration fee.
